Soldiers of Servanthood (S.O.S)

S.O.S refers to an encoded alert for a ship in distress. It is currently used as a modernized term to signify help in any emergency (i.e.: “save our souls”). For example, when a ship hits an iceberg and starts to sink, the people on that ship will cry for help for their lives to be saved. **This is very similar to life without salvation in Jesus Christ.** The people in this generation are crying out for help through reaping the results of an active sinful lifestyle (Romans 6:23). The unsaved people of this generation are in desperate need of a Savior. This is where the **servanthood of born-again** believers come into play. There are four practical components to servanthood that can enhance our effectiveness in saving souls:

1. Selfish ambitions must be put to death (through prayer, fasting, praise/worship, & meditating in the Word of God).

2. We must understand that we were once in the unsaved person’s position & God had mercy on our soul.

3. Relatable conversations can open doors for the Gospel of Jesus Christ to be preached. Conversational engagement of people’s idols can lead to guards being let down in order to receive the good news of The Gospel.

4. We must be available to meet people’s physical needs, which allows us to show God’s love through tangible examples.

These practical components of servanthood can open doorways for lost souls to be saved.
